



Barn hygiene and disease prevention

- using *Staldren*[®] in swine



General use of *Staldren*[®]

- Initially apply a handful of *Staldren*[®] (50-100g) per square meter.
- Thereafter apply once to twice weekly. In moist or wet areas apply more frequently.

Barn alleys farrowing, nursery, feeder barns

- Design your work program to attend to the youngest first and to the sick last.
- Consider boot sanitizing between barns, sections or pens.
- Apply *Staldren*[®] in a thin layer in alleys twice weekly to reduce the risk of spreading pathogens via movement corridors.

Breeding and maternity ward

- Spread *Staldren*[®] in pens twice weekly to keep pathogen pressure low and to enhance air quality by reducing harmful levels of ammonia and hydrogen sulfide.
- Ensure a clean and dry bedding surface. Dirty, wet areas are ideal sites for growth of disease causing pathogens.
- In deep bedding environments, e.g. straw, apply *Staldren*[®] to wet areas before fresh bedding material is spread.

Farrowing barn

- Prior to filling the farrowing stalls apply *Staldren*[®] to the entire area. Application with a motor applicator produces a more consistent even spread and increases efficiency of application.
- Following the birth of the piglets apply *Staldren*[®] daily for three days, particularly to wet areas, along edges and crevices.
- Apply *Staldren*[®] twice weekly until weaning particularly behind the sow, around the feed trough, the heating pad or piglet hut and other moist areas in the farrowing crate. This is where pathogens thrive.

Weaning/nursery barn

- When filling the weaning/nursery barn or pen use *Staldren*[®] three days in a row and thereafter twice weekly.
- Ensure the resting areas and wet/moist areas are prioritized.

Finisher barn

- Apply *Staldren*[®] 1 – 2 times weekly. This optimises barn hygiene, barn air quality and lowers disease risk.

Shipping and receiving

- Apply *Staldren*[®] on ramps used by barn staff.
- *Staldren*[®] is also an excellent choice for truck disinfection. Apply to a cleaned truck prior to use.
- Use *Staldren*[®] for sanitizing footwear as a dry bath.
